- The following forms included in this packet must be completed:
 - Application Form
 - Request for Records Form (students entering grades 1-8)
 - Copy of most recent report card and MAP test scores (students entering grades 1-8)
- Additional documents that need to be submitted are:
 - Birth Certificate
 - Baptismal Certificate
 - Custody Papers, if applicable (Official Court Order required)
- All students applying to Communion of Saints School participate in an ability assessment. Students are accepted in the following order:
 - Parishioner
 - o Parishioners of area Catholic churches without schools
 - o Children of other faiths/non-denominational
 - Communion of Saints School admits students of any race, color, and national or ethnic origin.
- Notification regarding the status of your application will occur after the assessment, by phone or mail.
- Upon acceptance, the remaining registration fee and tuition payment arrangements must made.

For families seeking financial aid, it is of primary importance that the FACTS form be completed. This is required to receive diocesan and/ or parish assistance. The FACTS form may be accessed online at: online.factsmgt.com/aid.

Communion of Saints School accepts EdChoice Scholarships. The application process starts with our school. Please contact the school office if you are interested in the EdChoice Scholarship.

- Registration will be considered complete when all records are received, new families have met with Father John McNulty and, tuition arrangements have been finalized.
- All Communion of Saints parishioners are required to schedule a meeting with the pastor, Father John McNulty, before acceptance is complete.

Mission

Who We Are

Our Students: Our students come from many different communities including Cleveland Heights, University Heights, South Euclid, Lyndhurst, East Cleveland, Cleveland and Shaker Heights. Bus transportation to and from Communion of Saints School is provided by the Cleveland Heights-University Heights and South Euclid-Lyndhurst school districts.

Our Families: In joining the Communion of Saints School family, you enter a community committed to building a caring, loving, and supportive environment for our children. This is evident in the way our families come together to support our PTO and Athletic Association. It can also be seen when our school families join in the worshipping life of the parish and participate in church-sponsored activities.

Our Learning Environment: Communion of Saints School provides a faith-filled, family-like atmosphere of learning for your child. Prayer is part of our daily activities and Sacramental opportunities are provided on a regular basis. Your child enters a supportive and nurturing community of learners. Just like a family, student, faculty, staff, and parents work to build positive relationships .Catholic schools like Communion of Saints School are known for academic excellence. In 2010, we were recognized as a National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence because our students score in the top 10% of students nationwide. If a student needs remediation or enrichment, resources are available from a very qualified team of auxiliary teachers including a speech and language pathologist, an intervention specialist, and a psychologist.

Our Safety Preparedness: Our school has a safety plan in place in order to respond to possible emergencies in an effective and expedient manner. We have regular in-services for faculty and staff on what role they play in the unlikely event an emergency occurs. Our School has regular fire drills, tornado drills, and intruder drills and has a very good relationship with the Cleveland Heights Police and Fire departments.

SPRITUALITY / PARISH MEMBERSHIP

Communion of Saints Catholic School is part of the mission of Communion of Saints Parish. Communion of Saints Parish was established in 2010 with the merging of four parishes in the community: Christ the King and Saint Philomena Parishes in East Cleveland and Communion of Saints and Saint Louis Parishes in Cleveland Heights.
