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Tuition & Scholarships

Catholic education is the starting point on the path to a lifetime of accomplishment for your child. Historically, our tuition has been significantly lower than the true cost to educate each child, which is approximately \$7,300.00. Communion of Saints Parish generously subsidizes the difference.
